

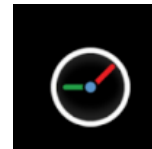

You can achieve this with several app on both android and iphone systems. The details below provide an overview for an app called TimeStamp Camera from Bian Di

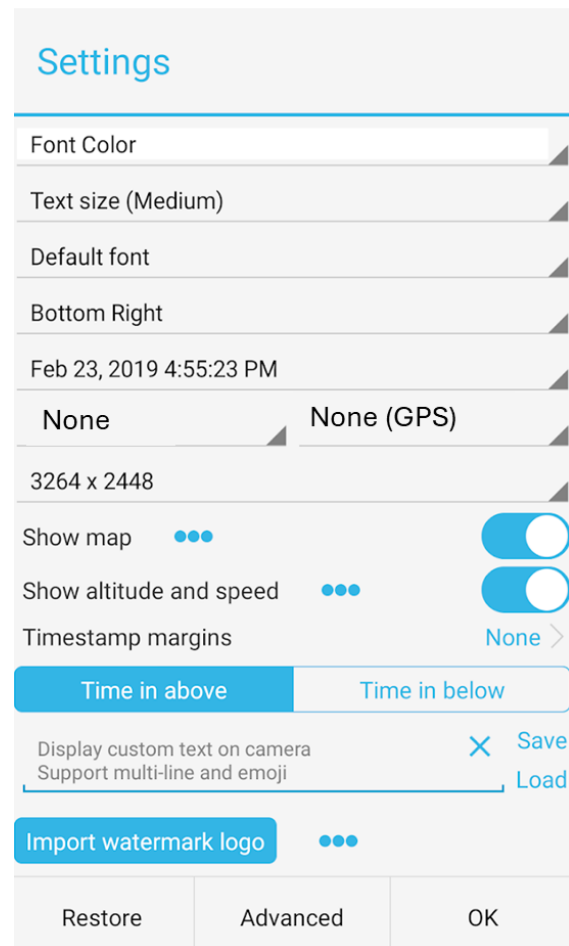
1) After installing the app, open it and click on the icon on the bottom right of your screen, which looks like this



2) You should now see a window with a lot of settings that looks like the one to the right.

3) in the field right below the date, click and scroll down until you see the “none” option. This will hide the address from the timestamp. The address is often determined by your phone’s location, and it does not always represent the address of the location you are taking a picture of.

4) the second location related option should already be set to “None (GPS)”. If not, please set it to that.
